Entity's Purpose or Mission: *

Canine Friends is a voluntary organisation providing competent and caring pet therapy visiting programmes where the benefits of canine company are shared with others. Our Mission Statement is "We share our dogs with people in need"

Entity Structure: *

Canine Friends is a nationwide organisation. There are 31 regions. Each region has at least one Liaison officer (LO). All 31 LOs report to either a North Island or South Island Field Officer.

Each region reports to the National Committee. The National Committee is responsible for setting and maintaining national standards, codes of conduct and necessary operational policies. All regions will observe the national standards, codes of conduct and any operational policies set by the National Committee.

Canine Friends consists of members who pay an annual subscription. Members can be ordinary (fee paying) or exempt (these are LOs or Assessors who have provided 2 years of service or Honorary members). Honorary Members are elected by resolution at the Annual General Meeting. Honorary Members are exempt from payment of subscriptions and enjoy full member privileges.

Committee meetings are held once a month. Quorum shall be five members. The current elected officers are:

Main Sources of the Entity's Cash and Resources:*

The main source of income for our organisation is from annual membership fees, grants, sponsorships and donations.

Main Methods Used by the Entity to Raise Funds:*

Canine Friends applies for grants to undertake specific strategic projects that will help us meet our purpose. We have secured a 3 year grant from Lotteries which is used to maintain our cloud membership management platform and our mobile communications with the regions. DogsNZ provide an annual donation which we use for educational purposes for our LOs. We use our membership fees to meet the operational needs of the organisation. We have also obtained a 3 year sponsorship deal with a NZ pet food provider (Ziwi) which has allowed us to promote the benefit of per therapy to a wider audience.

Entity's Reliance on Volunteers and Donated Goods or Services: *

Canine Friends relies on gifts of volunteer time and expertise to complete work in many essential roles such as governance, administration, communications & technology.

- 5. To work with hospitals and other institutions to ensure the continuation and smooth operation of the visitation programme.






Note 1: Accounting Policies "How did we do our accounting"

Canine Friends Pet Therapy Inc is not registered for GST. Therefore amounts recorded in the Performance Report are inclusive of GST (if any).


